

RE: Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE) Revised Codes of Good Practice B-BBEE

Status: Terry Sutherland & Associates cc (TS&A Events)

The Revised B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice in the Government Gazette 36928 of 11 October 2013 sets clear targets on Supplier Development (Amended Code Series 400).

TS&A Events qualifies as a Supplier Development and/or Enterprise Development Beneficiary as per Paragraph 3.7 (Amended Code Series 400). The attached sworn affidavit also serves as confirmation that TS&A Events qualifies as a Level 2 Black Owned Supplier.

Continued support of TS&A Events as a supplier has the secondary benefit of addressing the challenges presented by the Preferential Procurement section of the Revised B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice scorecard.

It is stated in Paragraph 4 and 5 (Amended Code Series 000) that an Exempted Micro Enterprise or Qualifying Small Enterprise with Enhanced B-BBEE Recognition is only required to obtain a sworn affidavit on an annual basis to confirm the Level of Black ownership and that the Annual Total Revenue of the entity.

The Revised B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice is therefore clear about the fact that a sworn affidavit submitted by an Exempted Micro Enterprise or Qualifying Small Enterprise with Enhanced B-BBEE Recognition should be accepted as confirmation of B-BBEE status by clients and verification agents.
